Here's Arif, another great NatWest employee who is now enrolled on the Graduate Finance scheme talking about his career choices.

I'm Arif, a Finance Graduate at NatWest and former student in the Social Mobility Foundation (SMF).

It's normal for A-levels and choosing your career to feel overwhelming because most people don't even know where to start. I know I didn't. Picking what I enjoyed felt like the right decision which is why I went for Maths, Biology and Chemistry. The more I thought about it, a future in sciences just didn't match up to what I wanted in a career.


That's why I applied to the Banking & Finance stream of the SMF's Aspiring Professionals Programme. These schemes are amazing, they give you access to guidance that is otherwise hard to find. For example, my interning at an investment company was the most valuable experience to me. I'm so thankful for my mentor's advice and reassurance throughout all my application processes. My first introduction to a business environment let me know immediately that it was something I wanted to pursue.

SMF's support continued into university with their skills webinars and guidance. I'll always be grateful for them making each transition comfortable and giving me the tools to thrive at work. It's also why I look forward to coming full circle and passing on all my tips to the next generation – I'll be volunteering to become an SMF mentor myself.

One last piece of advice from me, don't get too anxious about your future. Take your time, understand your preferences and look for a path that suits you.

#### Recruit

Recruit the right volunteers – years planners, job role sheets and assembly planners.

#### Recognise

Recognise skills and development – badges and icons to recognise young people's development AND templates and tools to help recognise YOUR local needs and future workforce LMI.

#### Reward

Reward their commitment – certificates and outlines for school year plans and meetings and how to gain recognition for your school as an NCW Career Champion School.









We've created a number of short videos to help you understand why an NCW Career Champion / Ambassador programme is a great idea for your school and also how it helps your entire learning community to become more in-tune with the needs of local employers and industry.
